SESSION 2: Courtroom Prayer — Presenting Your Case

Core Truth:

Prayer is not just asking—it is **presenting truth before God’s throne**.

Key Scriptures:

- Isaiah 43:25–26
- Luke 18:1–8
- Zechariah 3:1–5
- Revelation 12:10

Points of meditation:

- Satan as accuser
- Legal ground vs illegal ground
- God responds to **His Word**
- The difference between emotional prayer and legal prayer

ACTIVATION EXERCISE: “Build Your Case”

Instructions:

1. Identify a personal struggle (fear, delay, conflict, etc.)
2. Find 3–5 Scriptures related to that issue
3. Present it in structured prayer

Template:

- Address God
- State your position in Christ
- Present Scripture
- Reject the accusation
- Declare the outcome

HOMEWORK:

- Create a “**Prayer Case File**” for one ongoing battle
- Write Scriptures + declarations

Here's a fuller catalog of Satan's activity against believers, organized by function.

Accuser (legal/prosecutorial)

- Zechariah 3:1 — stands at Joshua's right hand to accuse him
- Revelation 12:10 — "accuser of our brothers... accuses them before our God day and night"
- Job 1:9–11; 2:4–5 — accuses Job of serving God only for benefit

Adversary / Opposer

- 1 Peter 5:8 — "your adversary the devil prowls around like a roaring lion, seeking someone to devour"
- Zechariah 3:1 (again) — the Hebrew *satan* itself means "adversary/opposer" by definition
- 1 Thessalonians 2:18 — "we wanted to come to you... but Satan hindered us"
- Daniel 10:12–13 — the "prince of the kingdom of Persia" opposes the angelic messenger for 21 days (spiritual opposition blocking answered prayer)

Destroyer

- John 10:10 — "the thief comes only to steal and kill and destroy"
- 1 Corinthians 5:5 — handing over "to Satan for the destruction of the flesh"
- Revelation 9:11 — the angel of the abyss named Abaddon/Apollyon, "the Destroyer"
- 1 Peter 5:8 (again) — "seeking someone to devour"

Deceiver

- Revelation 12:9 — "that ancient serpent... who deceives the whole world"
- Revelation 20:7–10 — released to "deceive the nations" before final judgment
- 2 Corinthians 11:14 — "Satan disguises himself as an angel of light"
- Genesis 3:1–5, 13 — the original deception in Eden; Eve says "the serpent deceived me"
- 2 Corinthians 11:3 — fear that believers' minds may be led astray "as the serpent deceived Eve by his cunning"

Tempter / Influencer

- Matthew 4:1–11 (Luke 4:1–13) — tempts Jesus in the wilderness
- 1 Chronicles 21:1 — "Satan stood against Israel and incited David" to take the census
- Luke 22:31 — "Satan has demanded to sift you like wheat" (Peter)
- John 13:2, 27 — "the devil had already put it into the heart of Judas" / "Satan entered into him"
- Acts 5:3 — Satan filled Ananias's heart to lie to the Holy Spirit
- 1 Timothy 4:1 — "deceitful spirits and teachings of demons" leading people from the faith
- Ephesians 6:11 — "the schemes of the devil"
- 1 Corinthians 7:5 — Satan tempting through lack of self-control

- 2 Corinthians 2:11 — Paul warns against letting Satan "outwit us," noting "we are not ignorant of his schemes"

Blinder / Deceiver of unbelievers specifically

- 2 Corinthians 4:4 — "the god of this age has blinded the minds of unbelievers"
- Luke 8:12 — the devil "comes and takes away the word from their hearts, so that they may not believe and be saved"

Hinderer of God's messengers/work

- Daniel 10:12–13 (as above)
- Revelation 2:10 — "the devil is about to throw some of you into prison, that you may be tested"

AANKLAER

Sagaría 3:1 — "DAARNA het Hy my Josua, die hoëpriester, laat sien, terwyl hy voor die Engel van die Here staan, en die Satan aan sy regterhand staan om hom aan te klæ."

Openbaring 12:10 — "Toe hoor ek 'n groot stem in die hemel sê: Nou het die heil en die krag en die koningskap die eiendom van onse God geword, en die mag van sy Christus; want die aanklaer van ons broeders is neergewerp, hy wat hulle aanklaag voor onse God, dag en nag."

1 Thessalonicense 2:18 — "Daarom wou ons na julle toe kom, ek Paulus, meer as een maal; maar die Satan het ons verhinder."

Daniël 10:12–13 — "maar die vors van die koninkryk van die Perse het een-en-twintig dae lank teenoor my gestaan, en kyk, Mígaël, een van die vernaamste vorste, het gekom om my te help; en ék het daar oorgebly by die konings van Persië."

VERWOESTER

Johannes 10:10 — "Die dief kom net om te steel en te slag en te verwoes. Ek het gekom, dat hulle lewe en oorvloed kan hê."

1 Korinthiërs 5:5 — "om so iemand aan die Satan oor te lewer tot verderf van die vlees, sodat die gees gered kan word in die dag van die Here Jesus."

Openbaring 9:11 — "En hulle het as koning oor hulle die engel van die afgrond; sy naam in Hebreeus is Abáddon, en in Grieks het hy die naam van Apóllion."

BEDRIEËR

Openbaring 12:9 — "En die groot draak is neergewerp, die ou slang wat genoem word duiwel en Satan, wat die hele wêreld verlei, hy is neergewerp op die aarde, en sy engele is saam met hom neergewerp."

Openbaring 20:7–8 — "EN wanneer die duisend jaar voleindig is, sal die Satan uit sy gevangenis ontbind word; en hy sal uitgaan om die nasies te verlei wat in die vier hoeke van die aarde is, die Gog en die Magog, om hulle te versamel vir die oorlog; en hulle getal is soos die sand van die see."

2 Korinthiërs 11:14 — "En geen wonder nie! Want die Satan self verander hom in 'n engel van die lig."

2 Korinthiërs 11:3 — "Maar ek vrees dat, net soos die slang Eva deur sy listigheid bedrieg het, julle sinne so miskien bedorwe kan raak, vervreemd van die opregtheid teenoor Christus."

Génesis 3:1, 4–5 — "MAAR die slang was listiger as al die diere van die veld wat die Here God gemaak het... Toe sê die slang vir die vrou: Julle sal gewis nie sterwe nie; maar God weet dat as julle daarvan eet, julle oë sal oopgaan, sodat julle soos God sal wees deur goed en kwaad te ken."

Génesis 3:13 — "Daarop sê die Here God aan die vrou: Wat het jy nou gedoen? En die vrou antwoord: Die slang het my bedrieg, en ek het geëet."

VERSOEKER / BEÏNVLOEDER

Matthéüs 4:1, 3 — "TOE is Jesus deur die Gees weggelei die woestyn in om versoek te word deur die duiwel... En die versoeker het na Hom gekom en gesê: As U die Seun van God is, sê dat hierdie klippe brode word."

1 Kronieke 21:1 — "TOE het Satan teen Israel opgetree en Dawid aangehits om Israel te tel."

Lukas 22:31–32 — "EN die Here sê: Simon, Simon, kyk, die Satan het vurig begeer om julle soos koring te sif. Maar Ek het vir jou gebid, dat jou geloof nie ophou nie; en as jy eendag bekeerd is, moet jy jou broeders versterk."

Lukas 22:3 — "En die Satan het in Judas gevaar, wat Iskariot genoem word en wat uit die getal van die twaalf was."

Johannes 13:2 — "En gedurende die maaltyd — die duiwel het dit al in die hart van Judas Iskariot, die seun van Simon, ingegee om Hom te verrai."

Johannes 13:27 — "En nadat hy die stukkies geneem het, het die Satan in hom ingevaar. En Jesus sê vir hom: Wat jy doen, doen dit haastig."

Handelinge 5:3 — "Toe sê Petrus: Ananias, waarom het die Satan jou hart vervul om vir die Heilige Gees te lieg en van die prys van die grond agter te hou?"

1 Timótheüs 4:1 — "MAAR die Gees sê uitdruklik dat in die laaste tye sommige van die geloof afvallig sal word en verleidende geeste en leringe van duiwels sal aanhang."

Efésiërs 6:11 — "Trek die volle wapenrusting van God aan, sodat julle staande kan bly teen die liste van die duiwel."

1 Korinthiërs 7:5 — "Onttrek julle nie aan mekaar nie, behalwe met wedersydse ooreenstemming vir 'n tyd lank om julle aan vas en gebed te kan wy; en kom weer bymekaar, sodat die Satan julle nie in versoeking bring deur julle gebrek aan selfbeheersing nie."

2 Korinthiërs 2:11 — "want ons is met sy planne nie onbekend nie" (*vollediger: "sodat ons nie deur die Satan bedrieg sou word nie; want ons is met sy planne nie onbekend nie."*)

VERBLINDER VAN ONGELOWIGES

2 Korinthiërs 4:4 — "naamlik die ongelowiges in wie die god van hierdie wêreld die sinne verblind het, sodat die verligting van die evangelie van die heerlijkheid van Christus, wat die beeld van God is, op hulle nie sou skyn nie."

Lukas 8:12 — "Dié langs die pad is die hoorders. Daarna kom die duiwel en neem die woord uit hul harte weg, sodat hulle nie sou glo en gered word nie."

HINDERAR VAN GOD SE BOODSKAPPERS

Daniël 10:12–13 (*soos bo*)

Openbaring 2:10 — "Vrees vir niks wat jy sal ly nie. Kyk, die duiwel gaan sommige van julle in die gevangenis werp, sodat julle op die proef gestel kan word; en julle sal tien dae lank verdrukking hê. Wees getrou tot die dood toe, en Ek sal jou die kroon van die lewe gee."

ANTWOORDE

Openbaring 12:11 — "En hulle het hom oorwin deur die bloed van die Lam en deur die woord van hulle getuigenis, en hulle het tot die dood toe hulle lewe nie liefgehad nie."

Romeine 8:33–34 — "Wie sal beskuldiging inbring teen die uitverkorenes van God? God is dit wat regverdig maak. Wie is dit wat veroordeel? Christus is dit wat gesterf het, ja, meer nog, wat ook opgewek is, wat ook aan die regterhand van God is, wat ook vir ons intree."

1 Johannes 2:1 — "MY kinders, ek skryf hierdie dinge aan julle, dat julle nie moet sondig nie; en as iemand gesondig het, ons het 'n Voorspraak by die Vader, Jesus Christus, die Regverdige."

1 Petrus 5:8–9 — "Wees nugter en waaksaam, want julle teëstander, die duiwel, loop rond soos 'n brullende leeu en soek wie hy kan verslind. Hom moet julle teëstaan, standvastig in die geloof."

Jakobus 4:7 — "Onderwerp julle dan aan God; weerstaan die duiwel, en hy sal van julle wegvlug."

Johannes 8:32 — "En julle sal die waarheid ken, en die waarheid sal julle vrymaak."

Matthéüs 26:41 — "Waak en bid, dat julle nie in versoeking kom nie. Die gees is wel gewillig, maar die vlees is swak."

Efésiërs 4:27 — "en gee aan die duiwel geen plek nie."

1 Korinthiërs 10:13 — "Geen versoeking het julle aangegryp behalwe 'n menslike nie; maar God is getrou, wat nie sal toelaat dat julle bo julle kragte versoek word nie; maar Hy sal saam met die versoeking ook die uitkoms gee, sodat julle dit sal kan verdra."

2 Korinthiërs 4:6 — "Want God wat gesê het dat daar uit duisternis lig moet skyn — dit is Hy wat in ons harte geskyn het om die verligting te bring van die kennis van die heerlijkheid van God in die aangesig van Jesus Christus."

Efésiërs 6:10–18 — "EINDELIK, my broeders, word kragtig in die Here en in die krag van sy sterkte. Trek die volle wapenrusting van God aan, sodat julle staande kan bly teen die list van die duiwel. Want ons worstelstryd is nie teen vlees en bloed nie, maar teen die owerhede, teen die magte, teen die wêreldheersers van die duisternis van hierdie eeu, teen die bose geeste in die lug. Daarom, neem die volle wapenrusting van God op, sodat julle weerstand kan bied in die dag van onheil en, nadat julle alles volbring het, staande kan bly. Staan dan vas, julle lendene met die waarheid omgord, met die borswapen van die geregtigheid aan, en as skoene aan julle voete die bereidheid vir die evangelie van vrede. Behalwe dit alles neem die skild van die geloof op waarmee julle al die vurige pyle van die Bose sal kan uitblus. En neem aan die helm van verlossing en die swaard van die Gees — dit is die woord van God — terwyl julle met alle gebed en smeking by elke geleentheid bid in die Gees."

SESSION 2: Courtroom Prayer — Presenting Your Case

Using Zechariah 3:1–7

1. The Courtroom Scene

The Roles in the Court:

- **Joshua the High Priest** → The believer (you)
- **Satan** → The accuser (prosecution)
- **The Angel of the Lord** → Judge *and* Advocate (this points to Christ)
- **Attending angels** → Witnesses / court officials

This is not chaos—this is **order, structure, and legal process**.

Prayer here is not random talking.
It is **engaging a legal system**.

2. The Problem: Accusation Has Legal Ground

“Joshua was standing before the angel... and Satan standing at his right side to accuse him.” (v.1)

This is critical.

Satan is not shouting lies randomly.
He is presenting a **case based on evidence**.

And the evidence?

“Now Joshua was dressed in filthy clothes...” (v.3)

That represents:

- Sin
- Compromise
- Guilt
- Legal vulnerability

Principle:

The enemy’s power is in **legal grounds**, not noise.

3. The Turning Point: Divine Intervention

God does **three things**:

1. Rebukes the accuser (v.2)

Not Joshua—**Satan is addressed first**

Why? Because the case must be dealt with legally

2. Removes the filthy garments (v.4)

“See, I have taken away your sin...”

This is not symbolic—this is:

Legal cleansing

The evidence is removed.

3. Re-clothes him (v.4–5)

New garments = righteousness, restored identity

Now Joshua is no longer guilty in the court

4. The Result: Access and Authority (v.7)

“I will give you a place among those standing here.”

Now he is:

- No longer accused
- No longer disqualified
- No longer silent

He is now:

Authorized to stand, move, and function in the court

5. Turning This Into a Prayer Weapon

STEP-BY-STEP: COURTROOM PRAYER MODEL

Step 1: Enter the Court (Position Yourself)

Not emotionally—**intentionally**

“Father, I come before You in the name of Jesus.”

You’re not hoping to be heard—you are:

Entering legally through Christ

Step 2: Acknowledge the Judge

Establish alignment:

“You are righteous, just, and faithful in all Your ways.”

This anchors the case in **God’s nature**

Step 3: Identify the Accusation

Be honest—this is where most people avoid truth.

Ask:

- Where does the enemy have a case?
- What is he accusing me of?

Then say it plainly:

“Lord, I acknowledge where I have been wrong...”

Step 4: Present the Blood of Jesus (Critical)

This is where most believers fail—they stop at confession.

You go further:

“I place the finished work of Jesus over this matter.”

You are not defending yourself

You are presenting **legal payment**

Step 5: Reject the Accuser

Now you speak *against the prosecution*:

“Every accusation against me is cancelled by the blood of Jesus.”

This mirrors:

“The Lord rebuke you, Satan!” (v.2)

Step 6: Receive Your Position

Don’t stay in guilt.

Declare:

“I receive my righteousness in Christ. I stand accepted before God.”

This is where many lose authority—they never step into position.

Step 7: Present Your Case

Now you move from defense → **offense**

Bring your request:

- Promises from Scripture
- God’s will
- Covenant truth

Example:

“Based on Your Word, I present this situation before You...”

Step 8: Enforce the Verdict

Now you don’t beg—you **establish**:

“I declare that Your will is established in this matter.”

This is where prayer becomes **a weapon**

6. Core Teaching Truths

1. Prayer is not just relational—it is legal

God is Father, yes—but also **Judge**

2. The enemy works through accusation

If accusation stands, authority is weakened

3. Cleansing restores access

Access is not earned—it is restored through Christ

4. Access leads to authority

You don't just enter—you **operate**.

5. Authority allows enforcement

You don't just ask—you **establish**.

7. Activation

Guided Prayer :

- What accusation has been hanging over your life?
- Where do you feel disqualified?
- What area do you avoid bringing before God?

Prayer lead :

1. Enter the court
2. Confess clearly
3. Apply the blood
4. Reject accusation
5. Step into righteousness
6. Present their case
7. Declare the outcome

Stop and Think

Most people pray like this:

- Emotional
- Vague
- Passive

But Zechariah 3 shows:

Heaven operates with **order, legality, and authority**

When you understand that:

- You stop begging
- You stop doubting
- You stop shrinking back

And you start:

Standing in court like someone who belongs there

1. No More Accusation Through Christ

Romans 8:1

“There is therefore now no condemnation to them which are in Christ Jesus, who walk not after the flesh, but after the Spirit.”

Romans 8:33–34

“Who shall lay any thing to the charge of God’s elect? It is God that justifieth. Who is he that condemneth? It is Christ that died, yea rather, that is risen again, who is even at the right hand of God, who also maketh intercession for us.”

Courtroom language again:

- “charge”
- “justify”
- “condemn”

This is legal positioning, not emotional comfort.

Revelation 12:10–11

“Now is come salvation, and strength, and the kingdom of our God, and the power of his Christ: for the accuser of our brethren is cast down, which accused them before our God day and night. And they overcame him by the blood of the Lamb, and by the word of their testimony...”

Key truth:

- The accuser **was active**
- But is **overcome by the blood**

Colossians 2:13–14

“And you, being dead in your sins... hath he quickened together with him, having forgiven you all trespasses; Blotting out the handwriting of ordinances that was against us... and took it out of the way, nailing it to his cross.”

That’s legal debt cancellation.

2. Pulled from the Fire (Rescue & Salvation)

Zechariah 3:2 (your base text)

“...Is not this a brand plucked out of the fire?”

Jude 1:23

“And others save with fear, pulling them out of the fire; hating even the garment spotted by the flesh.”

Amos 4:11

“...ye were as a firebrand plucked out of the burning...”

Colossians 1:13–14

“Who hath delivered us from the power of darkness, and hath translated us into the kingdom of his dear Son:

In whom we have redemption through his blood, even the forgiveness of sins:”

Not improved—**rescued and relocated**.

2 Timothy 4:18

“And the Lord shall deliver me from every evil work, and will preserve me unto his heavenly kingdom...”

3. Garments Cleansed / Replaced & Debts Removed

Isaiah 61:10

“I will greatly rejoice in the Lord... for he hath clothed me with the garments of salvation, he hath covered me with the robe of righteousness...”

Isaiah 1:18

“Though your sins be as scarlet, they shall be as white as snow...”

Revelation 7:14

“...These are they which came out of great tribulation, and have washed their robes, and made them white in the blood of the Lamb.”

2 Corinthians 5:21

“For he hath made him to be sin for us, who knew no sin; that we might be made the righteousness of God in him.”

This is the **great exchange**.

Colossians 3:9–10

“...ye have put off the old man with his deeds;
And have put on the new man...”

Ephesians 4:22–24

“...put off... the old man...
And... put on the new man, which after God is created in righteousness and true holiness.”

Psalms 103:12

“As far as the east is from the west, so far hath he removed our transgressions from us.”

Micah 7:18–19

“...he delighteth in mercy...
Thou wilt cast all their sins into the depths of the sea.”

Hebrews 8:12

“For I will be merciful to their unrighteousness, and their sins and their iniquities will I remember no more.”

This leads to one powerful conclusion:

You don’t fight for acceptance—you fight FROM a justified position.

“The enemy argues from your past, but God rules from the finished work of Christ.”

COURTROOM PRAYER (Detailed)

Presenting Your Case Before God

STEP 1: Enter the Court (Access Through Christ)

Pray:

Father, I come before You in the name of Jesus.
I thank You that I have access to You through Him.
Your Word says in *Romans 8:1*:

“There is therefore now no condemnation to them which are in Christ Jesus...”

I do not come condemned—I come accepted through Christ.

STEP 2: Acknowledge God as Righteous Judge

Pray:

Lord, You are righteous and just.
Your judgments are true, and You justify Your people.

Your Word says in *Romans 8:33*:

“Who shall lay any thing to the charge of God’s elect? It is God that justifieth.”

I stand before You, trusting in Your justice and mercy.

STEP 3: Acknowledge Any Ground of Accusation

Be honest in your approach:

Pray:

Lord, I do not hide anything from You.
Where there has been sin, error, or disobedience, I bring it into the light.

Your Word says in *Isaiah 1:18*:

“Though your sins be as scarlet, they shall be as white as snow...”

I acknowledge my need for Your cleansing.

STEP 4: Present the Blood of Jesus (Your Legal Defense)

Pray:

Father, I present the finished work of Jesus Christ over my life.

Your Word says in *Colossians 2:13–14*:

“Having forgiven you all trespasses;
Blotting out the handwriting of ordinances that was against us... nailing it to his cross.”

Every charge, every record, every accusation against me
has been nailed to the cross of Christ.

STEP 5: Silence the Accuser

Pray:

I declare that every accusation against me is cancelled.

Your Word says in *Revelation 12:10–11*:

“The accuser of our brethren is cast down...
And they overcame him by the blood of the Lamb...”

I overcome every accusation by the blood of Jesus.
The accuser has no legal ground to stand against me.

STEP 6: Receive Cleansing and New Garments

Pray:

Father, I receive Your cleansing now.

Your Word says in *Isaiah 61:10*:

“He hath clothed me with the garments of salvation... covered me with the robe
of righteousness...”

I receive the robe of righteousness.
I am no longer clothed in guilt or shame.

Your Word says in *2 Corinthians 5:21*:

“That we might be made the righteousness of God in him.”

I stand before You as the righteousness of God in Christ.

STEP 7: Declare Your Rescue

Pray:

Thank You, Lord, that I have been rescued.

Your Word says in *Colossians 1:13–14*:

“Who hath delivered us from the power of darkness...
In whom we have redemption through his blood...”

I am delivered from the power of darkness.
I am no longer bound to my past.

I am a brand plucked from the fire—rescued by Your mercy.

STEP 8: Stand in Your Legal Position

Pray:

I stand justified before You.

Your Word says in *Romans 8:34*:

“It is Christ that died... who also maketh intercession for us.”

Jesus is my advocate.
My case is secured through Him.

I stand accepted, cleared, and established before You.

STEP 9: Present Your Case (Your Request)

Pray:

Father, based on Your Word and Your righteousness,
I present this matter before You:

[Speak your request clearly—be specific]

I bring this before Your court, trusting in Your will and Your authority.

STEP 10: Declare the Verdict (Faith & Authority)

Pray:

Lord, I trust Your judgment and Your faithfulness.

Your Word says in *Hebrews 8:12*:

“Their sins and their iniquities will I remember no more.”

Therefore, I stand free, forgiven, and restored.

I declare that Your will is established in this matter.
I agree with heaven’s verdict over my life.

Closing Declaration

I do not stand as the accused—I stand as the justified.
I do not speak from fear—I speak from righteousness.
I do not beg for access—I stand in it through Christ.

In Jesus’ name, Amen.

HOFSAAL-GEBED

Om jou saak voor God te stel

STAP 1: Betree die Hof (Toegang deur Christus)

Bid:

U Woord sê in *Romeine 8:1*:

“Daar is dan nou geen veroordeling vir die wat in Christus Jesus is nie...”

Ek kom nie as veroordeelde nie—ek kom as iemand wat aanvaar is deur Christus.

STAP 2: Erken God as Regverdige Regter

Bid:

Here, U is regverdig en reg.
U oordele is waar, en U regverdig U volk.

U Woord sê in *Romeine 8:33*:

“Wie sal beskuldiging inbring teen die uitverkorenes van God? God is dit wat regverdig maak.”

Ek staan voor U en vertrou op U geregtigheid en genade.

STAP 3: Erken Enige Grond vir Aanklag

(Wees eerlik voor God)

Bid:

Here, ek steek niks vir U weg nie.
Waar daar sonde, foute of ongehoorsaamheid was, bring ek dit in die lig.

U Woord sê in *Jesaja 1:18*:

“Al was julle sondes soos skarlaken, dit sal wit word soos sneeu...”

Ek erken my behoefte aan U reiniging.

STAP 4: Pleit die Bloed van Jesus (Jou Regsverdediging)

Bid:

Vader, ek bring die voltooide werk van Jesus Christus oor my lewe.

U Woord sê in *Kolossense 2:13–14*:

“Hy het julle saam met Hom lewend gemaak... deurdag Hy al die oortredinge vergewe het;
en die skuldbrief... uitgedelg en dit aan die kruis vasgespyker het.”

Elke aanklag, elke rekord, elke skuld teen my
is aan die kruis vasgespyker.

STAP 5: Maak die Aanklaer Stil

Bid:

Ek verklaar dat elke aanklag teen my gekanselleer is.

U Woord sê in *Openbaring 12:10–11*:

“Die aanklaer van ons broeders... is neergewerp...
en hulle het hom oorwin deur die bloed van die Lam...”

Ek oorwin elke aanklag deur die bloed van Jesus.
Die aanklaer het geen reg meer teen my nie.

STAP 6: Ontvang Reiniging en Nuwe Klere

Bid:

Vader, ek ontvang nou U reiniging.

U Woord sê in *Jesaja 61:10*:

“Hy het my beklee met klere van heil, my in die mantel van geregtigheid gewikkel...”

Ek ontvang die kleed van geregtigheid.
Ek is nie meer geklee in skuld of skaamte nie.

U Woord sê in *2 Korintiërs 5:21*:

“...sodat ons kan word die geregtigheid van God in Hom.”

Ek staan voor U as die geregtigheid van God in Christus.

STAP 7: Verklaar Jou Verlossing (Uit die Vuur Gered)

Bid:

Dankie, Here, dat U my gered het.

U Woord sê in *Kolossense 1:13–14*:

“Hy het ons verlos uit die mag van die duisternis...
in wie ons die verlossing het deur sy bloed...”

Ek is verlos uit die mag van duisternis.
Ek is nie meer gebind aan my verlede nie.

Ek is ’n stuk hout uit die vuur geruk—gered deur U genade.

STAP 8: Neem Jou Regsposisie In

Bid:

Ek staan geregverdig voor U.

U Woord sê in *Romeine 8:34*:

“Dit is Christus wat gesterf het... wat ook vir ons intree.”

Jesus is my Voorspraak.
My saak is vasgemaak deur Hom.

Ek staan aanvaar, gereinig en gevestig voor U.

STAP 9: Stel Jou Saak (Jou Versoek)

Bid:

Vader, op grond van U Woord en U geregtigheid,
bring ek hierdie saak voor U:

[Noem jou versoek duidelik en spesifiek]

Ek plaas dit voor U troon en vertrou op U wil en U gesag.

STAP 10: Verklaar die Uitspraak (Geloof & Gesag)

Bid:

Here, ek vertrou U oordeel en U getrouheid.

U Woord sê in *Hebreërs 8:12*:

“Aan hulle sondes en hulle ongeregtighede sal Ek nooit meer dink nie.”

Daarom staan ek vry, vergewe en herstel.

Ek verklaar dat U wil geskied in hierdie saak.

Ek stem saam met die uitspraak van die hemel oor my lewe.

Slotverklaring

Ek staan nie as die beskuldigde nie—ek staan as die geregverdigde.

Ek praat nie uit vrees nie—ek praat uit geregtigheid.

Ek smee nie vir toegang nie—ek staan daarin deur Christus.
